

Démolition de la grande télécabine Fiesch - Fiescheralp Restrictions d'exploitation à Fiesch dès le 19 août 2019

Dear Passengers,

Aletsch Bahnen AG is working for you on the construction of a new 10-seater gondola lift to Fiescheralp. From December 2019, the new railway station in Fiesch will incorporate both the train and bus terminals and the valley station of the new gondola lift up to Fiescheralp.

For this reason, the demolition of the existing Fiesch – Fiescheralp large-cabin cable car will get underway on 19 August 2019. The small Fiesch – Fiescheralp reversible aerial tramway (capacity 34 persons) will operate through to the end of the season.

The loss of the large-cabin cable car may result in capacity bottlenecks. The small Fiesch – Fiescheralp aerial tramway will run to and fro continuously when passenger traffic is particularly high. During this period there is no guarantee that the timetable will be adhered to.

To avoid longer waiting times, please note our other feeder railways that also take you up to the Aletsch plateau.



Tip: The Aletsch+ hiking pass includes free travel on all cableways operated by Aletsch Bahnen AG (Riederalp, Bettmeralp, Fiesch-Eggishorn) and on the train route Mörel – Betten valley station – Fiesch – Fürgangen.
